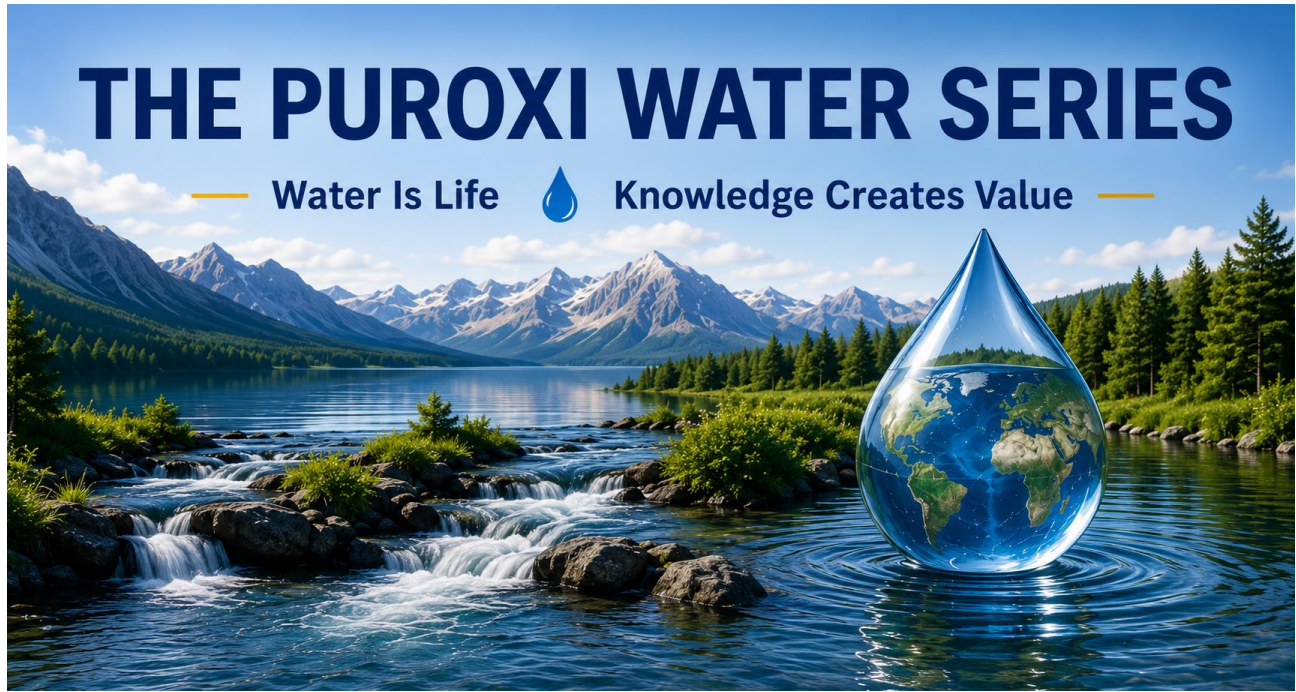

Some water began as snow high in the mountains.

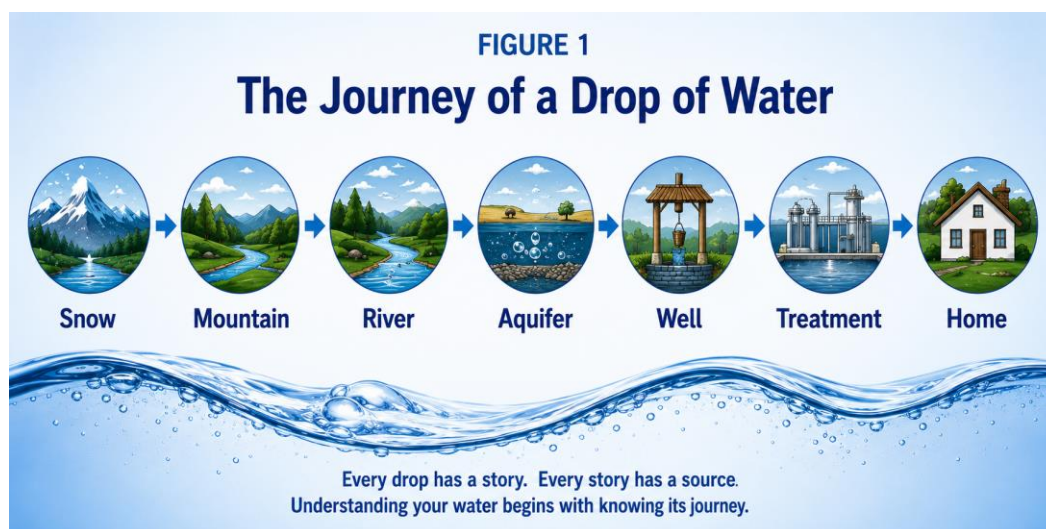
Some spent decades moving slowly through underground aquifers.

Every Water Source Has Its Own Fingerprint and DNA

Just as every person has unique fingerprints and DNA, every water source has its own identity.

No two wells are exactly alike.

No two lakes are exactly alike.

No two rivers are exactly alike.

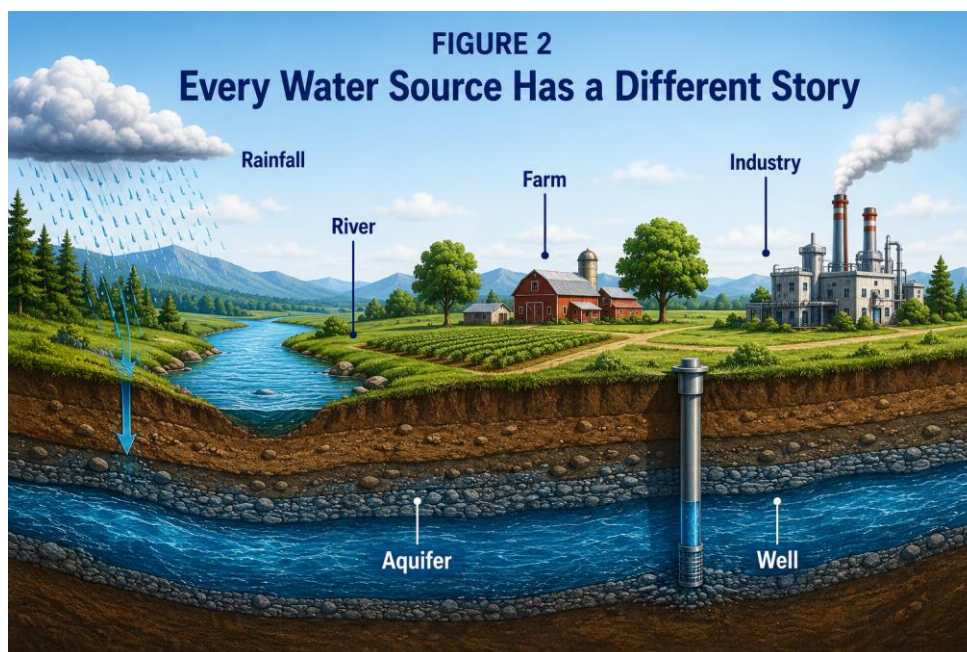
Even neighbouring properties drawing groundwater from different depths may have completely different water chemistry.

Every water source develops its own unique characteristics based on:

- Local geology
- Rainfall
- Snowmelt
- Surface runoff
- Groundwater recharge
- Agricultural activity
- Industrial activity
- Biological activity
- Seasonal changes
- Time

This unique combination creates the fingerprint of the water.

That is why successful water management begins with understanding your own water—not someone else's.



Water Never Stands Still

Many people assume their water remains the same throughout the year.

In reality, water is constantly changing.

Heavy rainfall may increase turbidity and introduce additional organic matter.

Spring snowmelt changes flow rates and nutrient loading.

Summer temperatures reduce dissolved oxygen while encouraging algae growth and biological activity.

Autumn introduces leaves and organic matter, while changing temperatures may cause lakes to undergo seasonal turnover.

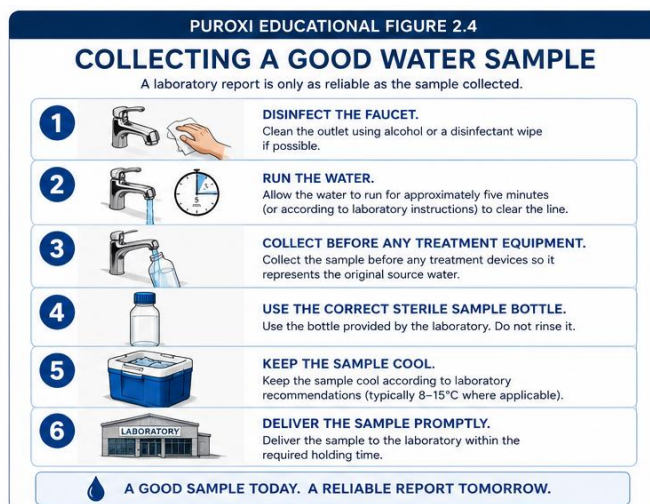
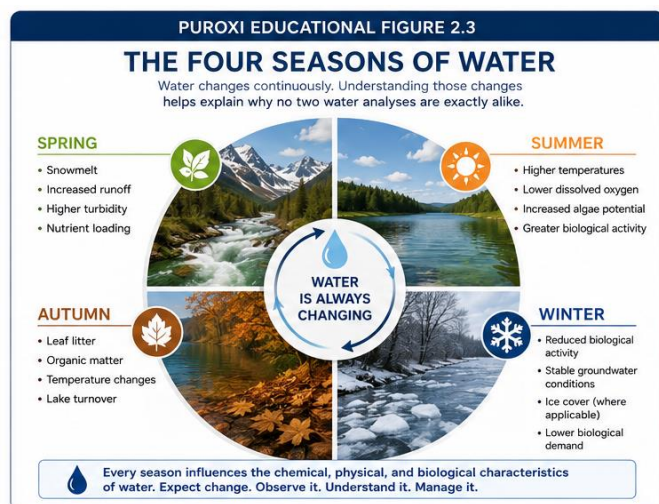
Winter often brings more stable groundwater conditions, although surface waters continue to change.

Every season changes the fingerprint of your water.

Understanding those changes helps explain why water analyses performed at different times may produce different results.

DID YOU KNOW?

Water collected from the same location in January may produce noticeably different laboratory results than water collected from that same location in July.

DID YOU KNOW?

Two neighbouring wells only a few hundred metres apart can produce water with significantly different mineral content and water chemistry because they may draw from different geological formations or depths.

That’s why one water analysis should never be assumed to represent another nearby source.

- Where does my water come from?
- Has my water changed over the past year?
- When was my last water analysis?
- Was my sample collected correctly?
- What is my water trying to tell me?

A Water Analysis Is Only the Beginning

A laboratory report provides valuable information, but it is only the beginning of understanding a water source.

Testing every possible bacterium, every dissolved mineral, every metal, every organic compound, and every potential contaminant would be technically possible in many situations—but it would also be impractical and unnecessarily expensive for most applications.

Instead, laboratories analyze the parameters most relevant to the purpose of the investigation.

A laboratory report becomes an excellent starting point.

Not the final answer.

Collecting a Good Water Sample

Even the world's best laboratory can only analyze the sample it receives.

Before collecting a sample, ask yourself:

- ✓ Was the faucet disinfected before sampling?
- ✓ Was the water allowed to run according to laboratory instructions?
- ✓ Was the sample collected before any treatment equipment?
- ✓ Was the correct sterile bottle used?
- ✓ Was the sample kept cool?
- ✓ Was the sample delivered to the laboratory within the recommended holding time?

A good laboratory report begins with a good sample.

What Is My Water Trying to Tell Me?

Perhaps the most valuable question we can ask is not:

"What treatment do I need?"

Instead, ask:

"What is my water trying to tell me?"

Water leaves clues.

Changes in colour.

Taste.

Odour.

Scale formation.

Corrosion.

Algae growth.

Fish behaviour.

Livestock performance.

Equipment wear.

Each observation tells part of the story.

The more carefully we observe, the better we understand.

And the better we understand, the better decisions we make.

- Where does my water come from?
- Has my water changed over the past year?
- When was my last water analysis?
- Was my sample collected correctly?
- What is my water trying to tell me?
